- Provides in-service training to public school professionals

- Work with the Public School Outreach Team to develop educational webinars.
- Co-facilitate regional “Kids Like Me” programs.
- Serves students in public school settings using all communication modalities.
- Communicates regularly with a broad variety of professionals.
- Works collaboratively with parents and professionals to develop positive and successful educational programs for students.

- Eligibility for Maine Teacher of the Deaf certification.
- Strong knowledge base in language and literacy development.
- Prior teaching experience with children who are deaf or hard of hearing, (K-8<sup>th</sup> grade).

- Knowledge of the variety of communication modalities used by students who are deaf or hard of hearing.
